CommuniCity's Pilot Framework

Key Components:

 Open Call Instruction Manual: A step-by-step guide on utilising open calls for piloting solutions.

• Toolkit for organizing agile piloting programmes: An introduction to the toolkit created for organising agile pilot programs, drawing on the expertise of the CommuniCity city partners.

 Interactive session on pilot planning: Participants will engage in a hands-on session to plan a pilot project

Digital transformation case studies: Case studies from cities that have undergone digital integration, spotlighting the skills identified as necessary and the approaches taken to cultivate them within their organizations.

• Innovation ecosystem engagement: Exploring how public authorities can collaborate with local innovation ecosystems to enhance their digital capabilities.

This meeting aims to establish a collaborative framework in EU and European Digital Innovation Hubs (EDIHs) to foster acceleration of digital deployment within the EU.
